The Devens' Utilities Department provides electricity, natural gas, water and sewer services to the Devens community. The basic infrastructure includes approximately 68 miles of power transmission line, 30 miles of gas line, 50 miles of water and sewer line, 3 electrical substations, 4 wells, 6 sewer lift pumps and a wastewater treatment facility. This basic system, in various states of condition, is continually being modified to meet the needs of growing community. Utility systems are being upgraded and expanded to provide adequate supply and reliable utilities to the growing development.

It is MassDevelopment's objective to provide competitive utility rates to Devens' customers. Although the Massachusetts Restructuring Act of 1997 does not apply to municipal utilities or to Devens, gas and electric rates are "unbundled" to allow our customers to compare our rates with those in other areas. To ensure our customers the best possible price for a reliable utility, our energy suppliers and operating and maintenance contractors are chosen on the basis of competitive bids. The energy components of the gas and electric rates represent the total purchased cost of energy and are adjusted on a quarterly basis as needed.

Electric

The electric energy supply for Devens is purchased from the ISO New England. Wellesley Municipal Light Plant is the operating and maintenance service provider.

Wastewater is treated at a state-of-the-art 3 million gallons per day wastewater treatment facility located at Devens. United Water provides the operating and maintenance services for the system. Rate tiers are as follows.
