

## Motor Vehicle Excise:

Motor vehicle excise taxes are due annually for every vehicle owned and registered in Massachusetts. Excise tax bills are prepared by the Registry of Motor Vehicles and billed by the local community where the vehicle is **garaged**.

The value of the vehicle is determined by the Manufactures suggested retail price (MSRP), and depreciated according to the following table:

New Car released in the year prior to manufacture	50%
In the year of manufacture	90%
In the second year	60%
In the third year	40%
In the fourth year	20%
In the fifth year and all succeeding years	10%

The minimum excise tax bill is \$5.00

The excise tax rate is \$25.00 per one thousand dollars of assessed value.

If you receive an excise tax bill for a vehicle that is no longer registered to you, you should file for Abatement through the Board of Assessors' Office.
