Subject: Notice to Devens Residents re: Water Bottle Delivery and Pick-Up

On Wednesday, April 17 a [notice](#) was sent to all Devens residents that included information regarding drinking water and contaminants known as Per- and Polyfluoroalkyl Substances (PFAS). The notice also listed dates and times that Devens residents can pick up bottled water at the Department of Public Works (DPW); since the majority of residents have selected to receive 5-gallon reusable water bottles delivered directly to their homes and following three weeks' experience with pick-up preferences, DPW is now revising its hours for pick-up.

24 HALF-LITER BOTTLES

- **Cases of 24 half-liter bottles will be available for pick-up at DPW (99 Buena Vista) on Mondays – Fridays (excluding holidays) from 8 a.m. – 3 p.m.**
- DPW can also respond to individual special pick-up needs if you contact us directly and schedule a convenient time.

5-GALLON REUSABLE BOTTLES

- For those who have already signed up to receive 5-gallon reusable water bottles, note that the next delivery will take place on June 13.
- **Please place your empty bottles outside in advance, and Nestle delivery staff will replace them with the same number of full bottles.**
- According to Nestle policy, delivery staff will only deliver water to residences with empty bottles placed outside; residences that do not place empty bottles outside will NOT receive a new batch of water on delivery days.
